

Business scholarships Facts for students

Each year, the W. P. Carey School of Business awards over \$1 million in scholarships to support student success. Students enrolled in W. P. Carey undergraduate programs are encouraged to apply.

Types of W. P. Carey scholarships

The W. P. Carey School of Business offers many scholarship opportunities including merit-based and need-based aid. Merit scholarships are awarded based on academic and/or extracurricular achievements. Consideration for needbased aid requires the appropriate Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to be on file at ASU for the year in which scholarships will be applied.

The application process is competitive with selection based on many criteria including academics, campus and community involvement, and financial need. Scholarship Selection Committees and/or academic units in combination with donors determine recipient selection for the scholarships offered.

Most scholarships require students to be **enrolled full-time** (12 or more credit hours) in the term the award is disbursed. Please email wpcareyscholar@asu.edu with any questions.

How to apply

Students enrolled in a W. P. Carey undergraduate program should apply through the W. P. Carey School of Business General Scholarship Application. This application is used to determine award eligibility for general business school and departmental scholarships. Scholarships are awarded based on varying "scholarship criteria," including GPA, leadership and community service, major, class level, financial need, and residency classification. Scholarship awards range from \$500 to \$10,000.

The W. P. Carey General Scholarship Application is available each year for awards to be given the following academic year. The application period opens November 1 and closes on February 1 of the following year. Complete the application every year to maximize your opportunities for funding throughout college.

- Upload a copy of your resume detailing internships, work experiences, educational accomplishments, and leadership positions
- Complete your required essays

Frequently asked questions

When will I know if I've received a scholarship?

Incoming first-year students will be notified in **April** while continuing and incoming transfer students will be notified in **June**. Application status notifications are sent to the student's ASU email.

When will my funds be disbursed?

Disbursement of business scholarships for the academic year begins on or about the first week of classes for the fall semester. Visit **links.asu.edu/disbursement** for financial assistance and disbursement information.

Can receiving a scholarship affect my other financial aid?

It is recommended for students to follow up with the Financial Aid and Scholarship Services Office (tuition.asu.edu/financial-aid) to determine if a scholarship impacts any other financial aid received. To learn more about maintaining your aid, visit links.asu.edu/maintaining-aid.

Are there scholarships for transfer students?

Students transferring in from another college may apply to the General Scholarship Application, as well as other scholarship opportunities available through W. P. Carey and ASU. Review the scholarship criteria to determine if you meet the requirements, including if the scholarship is available for transfer students. Most scholarship applications are available through the **ASU Scholarship Search Portal** (scholarships.asu.edu/scholarship-search).

Additional ASU scholarship opportunities

The **ASU Scholarship Office** administers various types of scholarships. Visit **scholarships.asu.edu** to explore your options:

- New American University scholarships: Offered to outstanding incoming undergraduate students as they pursue academic excellence at ASU.
- Private donor scholarships: Based on the criteria established by the donor. Dollar value and requirements vary.
- Non-university affiliated scholarships: Scholarship sources vary and include clubs, organizations, and/or foundations, at the state, regional, or national level, independent of any college or university.

ASU priority dates to be aware of include the following:

- January 15: File a FAFSA for the following academic year by this date to ensure the best aid package possible.
- January March: Electronically file scholarship applications via the ASU Scholarship Portal.
